#### Virtual OWA ANNUAL CONFERENCE

With the COVID-19 situation, all in-person events both at the Huronia Chapter level and at the OWA level have been cancelled until further notice, <u>BUT</u> the OWA Annual Conference will be held in the evenings, through Zoom Webinars.

John Pineau, OWA's new Executive Director, has been working to organize the conference in this new format and he has shared his proposed plans with me. Everything is still in the planning stages however here is a taste-tease of what is to come. The latest info will be posted on the OWA website as it becomes confirmed, so keep watching the OWA website and of course our HWOA website.

On Tuesday evening, following a welcome address from our President Paul Robertson, we will have a keynote speaker. The confirmation from the speaker is pending at the moment, but as those of us who have attended in the past, the topic is always of current interest and informative. Later, John Pineau will present the "State of the OWA" report, followed by two speakers who will give a "Forest Health Network Overview for 2020". The evening will end with a Q&A.

On Wednesday, the topics being proposed are an overview of the Economics Study Phase 1; Fleetwood Plantation Study update; Community Bioheat Heat Guide, and Ontario's new Cross-Laminated-Timber Producer. As usual, the evening will end with a Q&A.

On Thursday, it is proposed to have "Stick and Cavity Nests in your Woodlot", followed by a "Virtual Field Tour" – pre-recorded digital video with narration. There will be a Q&A prior to closing remarks.

I realize that affordable rural internet is not available to many of us, myself included, but we have time to organize ourselves within our COVID pods and circles appropriately and safely. Hopefully that way, we can enjoy these presentations, we do live in resourceful communities.
